



10TH ANNUAL WEM HARVEST MARKET

Saturday 28th September 2019, 9.00am to 1.00pm

The market will have three venues: Wem Town Hall (High Street, SY4 5DG), Wem Senior Club (Chapel St. SY4 5ER), and Wem Baptist Church (Chapel St. SY4 5ER).

Brief information on facilities etc. for stallholders:

- ❖ **Cost is £16 per table or for an equivalent space; a few smaller tables for £10 are available in the Senior Club.**
- ❖ Tables are approx. 5' x 2' 6".
- ❖ A link from the market website to your website can be provided.
- ❖ Large car park available in town centre and only a short distance from the halls.
- ❖ Covered accommodation with tables already set up.
- ❖ Market will be open to shoppers from 9.00am to 1.00pm with setting up and dismantling time of approximately an hour at the start and end of the market. Stewards will be present to support traders. Please ask if you would like help with loading or unloading.
- ❖ WCH is encouraging traders who will help inform shoppers about the uses of local products. Leaflets and short demonstrations would be especially welcome.
- ❖ Listing and details of stallholders will be given on www.wemlocal.org.uk. Stallholders wishing logos or pictures to be displayed should forward as .jpeg file to wemharvest@yahoo.co.uk
- ❖ There is a café at the Town Hall. The Senior Club does not have a café but there are a number of excellent ones in the High Street and the Civic Society will provide traders in the Senior Club with free tea/coffee. The Baptist Church usually operates a coffee morning when there is an event in the church.
- ❖ Balanced allocation of stalls to ensure that traders have good sales opportunities.
- ❖ Raffle and other activities to attract and encourage shoppers.

Terms and Conditions:

- ❖ All food stallholders should be registered with Shropshire Council's Environmental Health Services or their local environmental health services and familiar with relevant Food Safety regulations.
- ❖ Personal licence required for traders selling alcohol. Existing **off licence** for alcohol in Wem Town Hall, so there is no need to obtain a TEN.
- ❖ Stallholders must familiarise themselves with emergency procedures relating to venues.
- ❖ All accidents must be reported immediately to the chief steward who will be based at the entrance desks to the halls.
- ❖ Wem Town Hall operates the sole franchise for sale of refreshments. Any request to sell immediately consumable products in the Town Hall will be considered on a case-by-case basis in consultation with Town Hall staff.
- ❖ Alcoholic products and any form of gambling, e.g. raffle tickets, are not allowed within the Baptist Church site.
- ❖ All stallholders must comply with health & safety and other operational procedures as required by the 3 sites. Copies of current PLI certificates must be provided fifteen days before the market.
- ❖ Electrical equipment must be PAT [Portable Appliance Tested] certified. Stallholders must check with the Combine Harvesters if they intend to use any electrical equipment.
- ❖ Stallholders are responsible for the safety of their displays and equipment.
- ❖ Stallholders are warned not to leave their stalls unattended. The organisers cannot take any responsibility for loss to equipment or produce, or damage to persons or property.
- ❖ Flammable products and accessories e.g. gas cylinders are not permitted.

- ❖ Wem Town Hall, Wem Senior Club and the market organisers reserve the right to remove any inappropriate advertising or other material from traders' stalls.
- ❖ Stallholders are responsible for clearing the stall and spaces below and around it after the market.
- ❖ Bookings will be taken subject to produce/products fitting the criteria of the markets; essentially priority is given to (1) the balance of goods for sale in the market, and (2) traders who produce their own goods within an approx. 30-mile radius of Wem. Please note that it is not a first come, first served application process.
- ❖ Should you wish to withdraw your booking, we would be grateful if you could inform us as soon as possible so that stalls may be reallocated. No refunds will take place if cancellation takes place within 4 weeks of the market. Prior to 4 weeks, refunds will be made minus £5 administrative cost.
- ❖ We will add you to our circulation list when you submit an application form and contact you about future Combine Harvester markets. Please let us know if you do not wish to be contacted in future.
