HARVEST

Photographic Competition 2019 – rules & instructions.

1. The **subject** of the competition is 'Harvest', but the interpretation is wide:
 - a. The gathering of a ripened crop by human or animal.
 - b. The crop/yield from a single growing season.
 - c. The processing/product of the harvest, e.g. pickles, smoked fish
2. **Entry** should be a print photograph; dimensions of print must be no larger than 7" by 5". Electronic copies should, if possible, also be supplied to wemcivsoc@yahoo.co.uk so that images can be displayed on the Wem Local website (www.wemlocal.org.uk) and on Wem Civic Facebook page, and displayed in Wem Library.
3. The **Image** can be taken anywhere in the world.
4. The **name** of the photographer, d.o.b if under 16, location of the photograph and the date that it was taken should be written on the reverse in pencil.
5. The **Photograph** can be colour, or black & white.
6. **Competitors** can enter up to 4 photographs.
7. The **Cost** of entry is 25p per photograph.
8. **Entrants** must not be professional photographers. A professional photographer will be deemed to be someone who makes more than 25% of their annual income from the sale of their photographs.
9. **Entries** that have won other competitions may be eliminated at the judges' discretion.
10. **Wem Civic Society** will retain entries for use in projects or publications appropriate to the aims of the society and for display on the Wem Local website (www.wemlocal.org.uk) or the society's Facebook page. In all other aspects, the photographer retains copyright.
11. **No entries** can be returned.
12. The **Closing date** is Tuesday 1st October 2019 (noon) and the judges' decisions are final.
